

PRINCEVILLE CERT PROTOCOL FOR DISASTER READINESS

(Rev. 1/1/06)

STORAGE of EQUIPMENT:

Equipment will be stored at the Sunset Drive Clubhouse, Napo'okala Circle, Princeville in the locked CERT locker.

Each CERT member will have the combination for the lock on the CERT locker and shall become proficient in opening the lock.

Murray Hudson and Rick Drayton have a key to the clubhouse. In the event Murray or Rick is not available the clubhouse and storage room can be opened by any homeowner of Sunset Drive.

PRIMARY STAGING AREA:

It has been determined that the Sunset Drive Clubhouse is sufficient in size to accommodate the needs of a small to moderate number of disaster victims, therefore, the Sunset Drive Clubhouse is our PRIMARY staging area.

SECONDARY AND THIRD STAGING AREAS:

In the event of a disaster with a large number of victims or the Sunset Drive Clubhouse has become unusable the Prince Albert Park is designated as the SECOND alternate staging area. If the need for significant shelter from rain or other inclement weather arises the Church of the Pacific facilities shall be designated as a THIRD alternate staging area. Equipment from the Clubhouse will be transported to the appropriate alternate staging area by the first CERT responders.

PROTOCOL for REPORTING to STAGING AREA:

Team Leader Rick Drayton, or alternate team leader Murray Hudson will be notified by Civil Defense of the need for CERT involvement. The notified team leader will decide which staging area is to be used for CERT operations.

The notified team leader will contact Janice Olsen who will call all CERT members and report back with the results.

In the event Janice is not available, the notified team leader will make other arrangements for the calls,

CERT members will report to the Primary Staging area unless told otherwise by the person making the notification calls.
