Fines and prison terms may apply if found negligent!

In recent months, these Wedge-tailed Shearwaters were found killed by dog(s) in Princeville. March thru December is the nesting season for our Shearwaters.

- Keep your dogs on a leash or kenneled at all times.
- Use the public access trail to Queen's Bath. Stay on the coastal trail to avoid crushing nesting burrows.
- Keep your cats indoors.
- Report any loose dogs or incidents of bird injury and mortality immediately to:
